



Make your own sailing boat!

Paper boats can be tricky for little hands to fold, so try out this quick and easy little sailing boat - made with household items - that *really* floats!

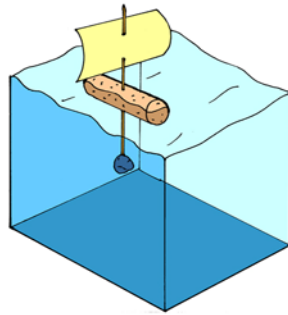
What you'll need:

A cork

Two cocktail sticks

Small piece of blu-tack

A square of paper (post-it notes are the perfect size)



Directions:

Step 1 Set the cork lengthways, then secure the cocktail sticks firmly in on opposite sides, as above.

Step 2 At the end of one of the sticks, help your child fasten a blob of blu-tack about the size of your little finger nail. This is the bottom of the boat.

Step 3 Give your child a post-it note or approx. 10cm x 10cm square of paper to decorate as a sail.

Step 4 Fasten the sail to the top cocktail stick by sticking it through twice, as shown.

Step 5 Float your boat!

Have fun racing your boat in the bath or see how the wind pushes them around on the local pond. Why not make a fleet of boats to and play with some friends?
