



Make your own spider's web!



What you'll need:

3 pipe cleaners (all the same size)

Wool or string

Directions:

Step 1 Take 2 pipe cleaners, and twist them together in the middle to make an X.

Step 2 Twist the third in too, so now you have a 6-pointed star shape like this ✨.

Step 3 You're ready to add the cobwebs: tie the wool to the middle of your star shape, then help your preschooler make an outwards spiral, wrapping the wool once round each 'leg' of the web to secure it.

Step 4 Aim to go round 3 or 4 times, then again tie the wool in a knot on one of the legs to hold it tight. Add some glitter or tufts of cotton wool to your web to complete the creepy effect.

Step 5 Your web's ready, where's your spider? Stick on a toy spider or make a mini creeper out of left-over pipe cleaners.



If you're really lucky, you'll spot a spider making his own web in the park or garden, see how quickly he works!
